



## Bankruptcy – Judgment Checklist

If you or your client has recently filed for bankruptcy and the filing includes an unsatisfied judgment that resulted in a driver's license suspension, the following documents are required to close the unsatisfied judgment suspension:

- Cover letter with the following information (if there are joint debtors, include information for all debtors):
  - Name
  - Driver's License Number or Social Security Number
  - Attorney's or bankruptcy document preparer's name and email address
  
- Notice of Bankruptcy Case Filing containing, at a minimum:
  - Date of the bankruptcy filing
  - Bankruptcy case number
  - Bankruptcy court name
  
- Schedule F that includes the creditor(s) related to the unsatisfied judgment suspension
