Commissioner meeting in South Bend focusing on regional campuses

The Indiana Commission for Higher Education met today for their monthly meeting at IU South Bend. Some of the

agenda items that were discussed were the topics of enrollment trends, return on investment reporting, student

financial aid and the recommendations of the regional campuses in Indiana.

The recommendation for a regional campus study came directly from SEA 98-2013, a directed legislative study

committee of eight legislators and a group on non-voting members, including two members from the Commission and

others from higher education, to study the governance and operation of regional campuses with a particular focus on

the needs of IPFW.

The Commission's 2010 regional campus policy was presented to the study committee along with supporting data. After

discussion with the committee and the testimony of representatives in prior meetings, Commission staff clarified and

revised the existing policy to more specifically address the current needs of regional campuses and the communities

they support. The staff recommended that the Commission approve the updated regional campus policy and submit it

to the Indiana General Assembly for consideration by the regional campus study committee. The Commission approved

the recommendations of the study committee.
