SURVEYOR'S REPORT

The purpose of this hearing is to increase the assessment to pay back the amount borrowed to complete partial reconstruction. The assessment for this partial reconstruction is \$298.00 per acre. The Charles Wilson 2 Tile watershed contains 520 acres. Partial reconstruction length of drain is 3,485 feet. 1,328 feet with 18" tile, 2,150 feet with 24" tile. Jim Sailors made a motion to accept the Schedule of Assessments and accept the actions of the board Jeff LeDonne 2nd; Motion passed.


Jim Sailors made a motion to set May 2017 as the first installment of the new assessment. Jeff LeDonne 2nd; Motion passed.
