The Grant County Health Department has reported **9 confirmed cases of COVID-19** in Grant County

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has identified 2,565 total presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 and 65 deaths and 14,375 tests in the state since Friday, March 6.

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) is closely monitoring the pandemic of the 2019 novel (new) coronavirus or COVID-19. ISDH is working with federal and local partners, including the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), to respond to this evolving public health situation. Locally the Grant County Health Department and Marion General Hospital are leading the efforts to stop the spread of the COVID-19 virus as well as take care of the people already affected by it. The entire emergency response community together with many other public and private organizations is working tirelessly to plan for an event none of us have ever seen before. Even with all of our best efforts and planning we cannot protect you from this virus, you have to protect yourself. The good news is it is relatively easy to do. Stay away from each other!
