COVID-19 Response / Planning

May 8, 2020 Daily Briefing

0900 Daily Briefing;

The Grant County Health Department has reported 169, confirmed cases of COVID-19 and 14 deaths in Grant County.

The Indiana State Department of Health (ISDH) has identified 23,146 total presumptive positive cases of COVID-19 and 1,328 deaths and 130,128 tests in the state of Indiana.

Effective Monday May 11, 2020 the Grant County EOC will de-escalate operations to Level III Activation; Grant County Health department and Emergency Management staff will maintain situational awareness of COVID-19 cases in Grant County and the region. Briefings with all Emergency Support Functions and other stake holders will be held each Monday and Friday at 09:00. Other briefings and notifications will be provided as warranted.

The Wednesday afternoon press briefings at Sunnycrest Baptist Church on WSOT TV will continue with more of a focus on Community services and events that are being planned as well as businesses that are open and how the public can access them.
