A MAG NAIL BY LS365 WAS RECOVERED, S15°E, 14' FROM THE PIPE. THE 2005 SURVEY PERFORMED BUY LS365 CITES "SET MAG NAIL OVER SPIKE-----HCSM." NO REFERENCE FOR THE CORNER WAS PROVIDED BY THE COUNTY SURVEYOR AND NO RECORDED SURVEY WAS DISCOVERED DURING RESEARCH FOR THIS SURVEY. WE USED THE AUDITOR'S FILES FOR A COPIES OF LS365 SURVEYS. THE MAG NAIL WAS REMOVED AND WE DID NOT FIND A SPIKE UNDER THE LS365 NAIL. THE 2005 LS365 SURVEY WAS COMPARED WITH A 2007 SURVEY BY LS365 AND THE SURVEYS WOULD CREATE A HIATUS OF OVER 16' BETWEEN THEM. THEREFORE THE LS365 MAG NAIL WAS DISREGARDED. THE POSITION OF THE PIPE WAS VERIFIED BY MEASUREMENTS TO ADJACENT CORNER MONUMENTS AND BY VERY OLD AND DISTINCT CULTURAL FEATURES IN THIS VICINITY. THE CORNERS RECOVERED, RESTORED, ESTABLISHED AND PERPETUATED BY THIS SURVEY ARE MARKED IN THE LEGEND. THE BEARING BETWEEN MONUMENTS IS GRID NORTH AS DETERMINED BY GPS SURVEYS.

HORIZONTAL AND VERTICAL CONTROLS FOR THIS SURVEY ARE BASED ON STATIC AND RTK GPS METHODS AND COORDINATES WERE CONSTRAINED TO AN NGS OPUS SOLUTION POSITION, INDIANA STATE PLANE COORDINATE SYSTEM, EAST ZONE, 1983 DATUM, FOR AN ON-SITE GPS BASE STATION. 



THE 2005 LS365 SURVEY WAS COMPARED WITH A 2007 SURVEY BY LS365 AND THE SURVEYS WOULD CREATE A HIATUS OF OVER 16' BETWEEN THEM. THEREFORE THE LS365 MAG NAIL WAS DISREGARDED.
