AMENDMENT OF MARTIN COUNTY CODE CHAPTER 73: TRAFFIC SCHEDULES

Resolution of the Board of County Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana:

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners is authorized to maintain highways within the County; and

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners is entitled under Indiana statutory law to establish maximum speed limits for operation of motor vehicles upon said highways; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners, in consultation with the County Highway Supervisor, has determined that the speed limit for Ironton Road should be adjusted for the safety of the motoring public; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County, Indiana, that the Martin County Code Chapter 73, Traffic Schedules be amended as follows to include the following provision:

Section (C) (1) This division (C) shall apply to Ironton Road beginning at the intersection of Ironton Road with U.S. Highway 50 and shall continue for 1800 feet south of said Ironton Road-U.S. Highway 50 intersection.

(2) The speed limit on Ironton Road shall be 25 mph.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Martin County Board of Commissioners ratify and restate all other provisions of Chapter 73, Traffic Schedules of the Martin County Code.
