

ORDINANCE ADOPTING MARTIN COUNTY COVID CLINIC GRANT FUND

WHEREAS, the Martin County Health Department shall be receiving funds from the Federal and Indiana State government for utilization in providing services to Martin County residents with regard to the COVID-19 pandemic; and

WHEREAS, said Federal and Indiana State government funds shall be received by Martin County Indiana on behalf of the Martin County Health Department, and,

WHEREAS, said monies shall be utilized by the Martin County Health Department to pay salaries and to purchase equipment for the establishment and operation of a Covid Clinic for the benefit of Martin County residents, and

WHEREAS, the Martin County Board of Commissioners now determine that it is appropriate to establish a fund for the deposit and administration of said Federal and State monies,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Commissioners of Martin County Indiana, as follows:

- 1. That a non-reverting Covid Clinic Grant Fund shall be established in the Office of the Martin County Auditor.
 - 2. That said fund shall be labelled Martin County Covid Clinic Grant Fund #8950.
- 3. That the Office of Martin County Auditor shall deposit all grant funds received from Federal and State sources into the Martin County Covid Clinic Grant Fund #8950.
- 4. That the Office of Martin County Auditor shall pay all legally documented claims received for the operation of the Covid Clinic by the Martin County Health Department from said Martin County Covid Clinic Grant Fund #8950 in compliance with all rules and regulations established by the Federal and State governments.

This ordinance shall be effective March 23, 2021
