JOINT PRELIMINARY INJUNCTION

The Court having considered and granted a motion and affidavit of _____ for a preliminary injunction;

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED BY THE COURT that Petitioner, _____, and Respondent, _____, be and they are enjoined and restrained from:

1. Transferring, encumbering, concealing, selling or otherwise disposing of any joint property of the parties or asset of the marriage except in the usual course of business or for the necessities of life, without the written consent of the parties or the permission of the Court;

2. Removing any child of the parties then residing in the State of Indiana from the state with the intent to deprive the Court of jurisdiction over such child without the prior written consent of all parties or the permission of the Court.

This order is binding upon Petitioner, at the time it is issued and effective upon all other parties upon service and remains in effect until further order of the Court or upon entry of a decree or final order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Clerk issue a certified copy of this order to the Sheriff of _____ County, Indiana, and said Sheriff is ordered to personally read and serve said copy of this Joint Preliminary Injunction upon _____ forthwith, and to file with the Court due return of such service.
