

When a youth is located after a runaway episode, the placement is entered into Kidtraks. Upon entering the placement, an alert will appear indicating the Human Trafficking Screener is to be completed within 5 calendar days of the youth being recovered. Click on the link in the alert box with the associated placement ID and the screener will pop up.
