An applicant for a mechanic license that has not successfully completed and passed a recognized program by the commission, must document their work experience and education. This documentation shall include specific areas of work experience and education, including but not limited to: Safety classes, Overview of elevator equipment, Print reading, Pit equipment, Guide rails, Machine room, Hoistway equipment, Escalators & Moving walks, Maintenance and repair/troubleshooting (including traction, hydraulics, escalators and other devices), Elevator doors, Construction Elevator ropes (including replacement), Hydraulic theory, Wiring, electronics, and solid state.

The documentation shall require under penalty of perjury, a signed letter by the employer and/or the mechanic that oversaw the work, details of work experience and education, and estimated number of hours completed in the appropriate areas of work experience and education. An applicant does not have to have work experience or education in all the listed areas, but must be able to demonstrate work experience and education in construction, maintenance, and service or repair.

REASON STATEMENT AND FISCAL IMPACT

IC 22-15-5-12 allows the department to ask for "Any other information the department requires" and that the applicant "Submit to the department any proof of eligibility the department requires".

Since the specific items were not called out for in the statute, staff felt it was necessary to add them into the rule to clearly give the department the legal authority to ask for these areas of experience. The language mirrors the draft mechanic application form that was discussed at a previous code meeting.
