An owner of a regulated lifting device shall place out of service their device if it is more than 45 days past the due date for its periodic test and send notice to the department.

**REASON STATEMENT AND FISCAL IMPACT**

The Division needs to see firsthand an elevator operating without a permit and therefore cannot shutdown the regulated lifting device. If the owner had to put the lifting device out of service if it was more than 45 days past the required test, the Division could then determine the regulated lifting device was not in compliance without actually seeing the device operate. Since the code says that an elevator that does not have a valid safety test is not in compliance, this simply has the owner take the device out of service.
