

Donohue Game Bird Area

Newton County, Indiana



Donohue Game Bird Area is an 80-acre parcel that was purchased in the winter of 1991-92. This acquisition was funded through the Game Bird Habitat Stamp Fund. The property has patches of prairie, annual weed patches, and some farmed areas.

Access is by written permit only and is awarded only for hunting opportunities, research, and volunteer conservation work. No other access is granted. Call Willow Slough FWA at 219-285-2704 for more information.

Directions: From Kentland, go east on S.R. 24 to Meridian Rd. (50 E.). Turn north on Meridian and travel 2 miles to C.R. 1400 S. Turn east onto 1400 S. and travel 2 miles. The property will be on the north side of the road. Park next to the wooden sign.
