The United States Army Corp of Engineers, Chicago District is planning to undertake routine maintenance work on the Michigan City Harbor Breakwater (Enclosure 1). The purpose of this letter is to coordinate this action with your office under Section 307 of the Coastal Zone Management Act.

The proposed maintenance work consists of repairs to the eastern detached breakwater at the mouth of the harbor's entrance channel. The work on the breakwater will consist of repairing and restoring the structure through placing new and resetting existing armor stone. This work will occupy the same cross-sectional area as the current breakwater.

The original breakwater was constructed in 1903 with the concrete superstructure added in 1923. Riprap was placed in 1939-40 and in 1968-69. The concrete cap was reconstructed in 1978. Periodic maintenance work has occurred repeatedly over the years, the extent of which is dependent on need and severity of degradation. Therefore, the boundaries shown on the figure show the extent possible over the life of the project. It is anticipated that the proposed activity complies with Indiana's approved coastal management program and will be conducted in a manner consistent with such program. Since this is an on-going maintenance project for a Federal Breakwater, the Chicago District requests a General Federal Consistency Determination for the life of the project. If maintenance areas change in the future, the Chicago District will request a new determination.


Michigan City Breakwater Repairs FY20








