The U.S Army Corps of Engineers, Chicago District (Corps) will be preparing a National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) document on the impacts associated with the proposed replacement of lift stations in Lake Station, Lake County, Indiana. The proposed activity complies with Indiana's approved coastal management program and will be conducted in a manner consistent with such program. The Chicago District is requesting concurrence from the IDNR/LMCP.

During significant rain events, the capacity of the existing sanitary sewers in Lake Station is exceeded due to infiltration and inflow. This results in sanitary sewer overflows (SSO) to the Little Calumet River, the Deep River and eventually Lake Michigan. These SSOs contribute to pollution and health hazards in the rivers, connected streams and ditches and Lake Michigan.

The Lake Station Sanitary District is working with the Corps to replace lift stations and reroute sanitary flows. Upgrading lift stations would provide additional pumping capacity. Rerouting sanitary flows would free up flow capacity, result in fewer SSOs, and improve the water quality in the rivers, connected streams and ditches and Lake Michigan. Project boundaries are shown in Enclosure 1.


