Crossing the Finish Line covers tuition, fees, books, and the cost of obtaining transcripts and any required College Level Examination Program (CLEP) tests at Ivy Tech Community College or Vincennes University for high school students who are just a few credits away from earning a credential of value.

By supporting our students in completing these credentials, we help them to increase their educational attainment, which leads to a better quality of life, increased wages, a healthier life, and increased career opportunities.
