

Indiana Full-Time Teacher Salaries and Benefits Report

Prepared by the Indiana Department of Education Office
of School Finance October 2022

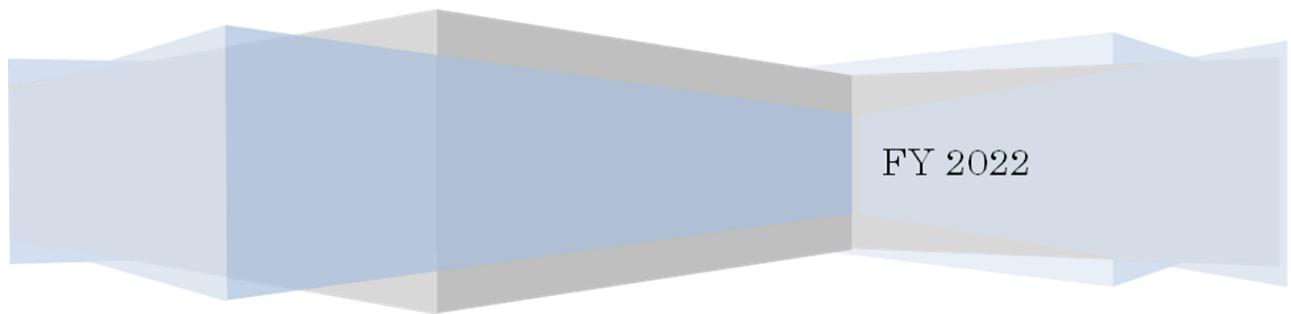


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Indiana Code requires the Indiana Department of Education (Department) to annually report to the Legislative Council and the State Budget Committee information concerning full-time teacher salaries and benefits. This report focuses on the requirements of IC 20-28-9-28, which includes the following content.

- (1) the percent and amount that each school corporation expended and the statewide total expended for full-time teacher salaries;
- (2) the percent and amount that each school corporation expended and statewide total expended for full-time teacher benefits, including health, dental, life insurance, and pension benefits;
- (3) whether the school corporation met the requirement set forth in subsection (a); and
- (4) whether the school corporation received a waiver under subsection (d).

EXPENDITURE REQUIREMENT FOR FULL-TIME TEACHER SALARIES

State law required that starting with FY 2022, school corporations must expend an amount for full-time teacher salaries that was not less than an amount equal to forty-five percent of state tuition support distributed to the school corporation during the fiscal year. (See I.C. 20-28-9-28) To comply with the legislative requirements, the Department requested new object codes and/or amended object code definitions and changes took effect July 1, 2021, to identify expenditures for full-time teacher salaries.

There are 290 school corporations included in the report, which covers the period of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022. Since charter schools were not part of the definition of school corporations for that part of the law, the Department excluded them from the report.

DATA USED

For purposes of the first annual report, the Department used two data sets.

1. FY 2022 (July 1, 2021 through June 30, 2022) Form 9 financial data reported by school corporations that reflected expenditures for full-time teacher salaries.
2. School corporations self-reported a survey on benefits expenditures for full-time teachers for FY 2022.

FY 2022 Form 9 Financial Data

- School officials file financial data, which includes, but is not limited to, revenues, expenditures, and cash balances. The data is filed in six-month increments and includes financial information for all state, local, and federal funds. To gather data needed to accurately track full-time teacher salaries, the Department requested modified and/or added new object codes in Summer 2021. Object codes reflect broad classifications for expenditures made by school corporations.

Object code classifications include Salaries, Benefits, Purchased Services, Supplies, Property, and Other Objects. Use of the various object codes provides the opportunity to analyze data in a categorical manner.

- The updates reflected the 100 series object codes. After the revision, the following object codes were part of the Chart of Accounts pertaining to salaries and benefits for the period July 1, 2021 to December 30, 2022.

Self-reported Survey of Benefits Expended for Full-time Teachers

The Department released a survey for school corporations to provide amounts expended for full-time teacher benefits during the period of July 1, 2021, through June 30, 2022. The benefits breakdown was broken into two columns representing state/local and federal expenditure amounts. There were twenty-one general benefit types, including social security, group health, life, dental, and vision. School corporations also had the ability to add benefits not listed in the survey. Benefit survey results can be found in Appendix B.

Methodology

For the following statistics, “per student” means the average of fall and spring Average Daily Membership (ADM). The category of “Large Size” school equates to the top quartile based on the number of students. “Mid Size” includes the middle two quartiles of students, and “Small Size” includes the bottom quartile. Likewise, “High Complexity” equates to the top quartile of complexity indexes, “Mid Complexity” includes the middle 2 quartiles, and “Low Complexity” includes the bottom quartile of the complexity index. Demographics including Metropolitan, Rural, Suburban, and Town are based on historical categorizations. See Appendix D for classification by school corporation.

Total expenditures for full-time teacher salaries was based on Form 9 expenditures for fiscal year 2022 and was determined as follows: [Object 110 full-time teacher salaries + Object 111 temporary teacher salaries] (numerator) divided by [total state tuition support amount on the June 2022 Form 54 monthly distribution report] (denominator). The numerator includes the referenced object codes from all school funds. State tuition support includes the basic grant, the special education grant, the career and technical education grant, and the honors grant. Since state tuition support for Indianapolis Public Schools includes several innovation network charter schools whose Form 9 financial data is reported separately, the amount of state tuition support was reduced proportionately for Indianapolis public schools.

Based on IC 20-18-2-22 (d), the term “full-time teacher” is defined as “An individual licensed under IC 20-28-5 who has entered into a regular teacher’s contract under IC 20-28-6-5 with a school corporation and whose primary responsibility is the instruction of students. An individual’s primary responsibility is the instruction of students if the individual provides instruction to students in a classroom setting for at least fifty percent (50%) of the individual’s workday. The individual’s workday is the number of hours the individual is expected to work each day under the terms of the individual’s contract with the school corporation. This applies to full-time teachers.” This term does not include some employees who are typically members of teacher collective bargaining, including counselors, psychologists, speech therapists, media center specialists, etc.

SALARIES

Percent and amount that each school corporation expended and the statewide total expended for full-time teacher salaries

Appendix A provides details on the percent and amount each school corporation expended for full-time teacher salaries as well as the statewide total. Using Form 9 financial data for FY 2022, the Statewide total was \$3,415,966,090.52, which was 47.65 percent of the total tuition support amount for the same period.

Three school corporations spent an amount which was less than 30 percent of state tuition support on full-time teacher salaries. Two of the school corporations, Clarksville

Community School Corporation and Union School Corporation, have a large virtual student population with virtual instruction provided by a vendor. Both districts use a contractor to provide those educational services and the contractual amount was excluded from the calculation. The third school, with the lowest percentage, was Lake Ridge Schools, who faces ongoing challenges with circuit breaker impacts and is a member of a special education cooperative as well as a career and technical interlocal agreement.

Fourteen schools expended between 30.83 percent and 39.88 percent toward full-time teacher salaries. Ninety-six school corporations had full-time teacher expenditures in the range of 40.09 percent to 44.86 percent, which was just shy of the 45 percent threshold. Twenty-one of those school corporations had expenditures for full-time teacher salaries between 44.1 percent and 44.86 percent.

Lastly, one hundred seventy-seven school corporations' expenditures for full-time teacher salaries exceeded the 45 percent threshold. There were two school corporations, West Central School Corporation and DeKalb that were outliers because of their high percentage of full-time teacher salaries. Both school corporations serve as the lead for a local education agency (LEA) based cooperative. Therefore, their expenditures reflect expenditures for full-time teacher salaries based at the cooperative as well as at the school corporation.

Using Form 9 financial data for full-time teacher salary information from all funds, the maximum per student amount calculated for full-time teacher salaries per student amount was \$8,437.72 in DeKalb County Eastern School Corporation while the calculated minimum amount of \$1,792.99 was in Clarksville Community School Corporation. As represented in Chart 1D below, the statewide median of teacher salaries per student was \$3,388.22, for all funds. The median for state/local teacher salaries per student was \$3,162.43 for state and local funds and \$219.21 for federal funds. Metropolitan school districts had the highest median of state and local salaries per student at \$3,288.80.

Chart 1D: Median Teacher Salaries per Student

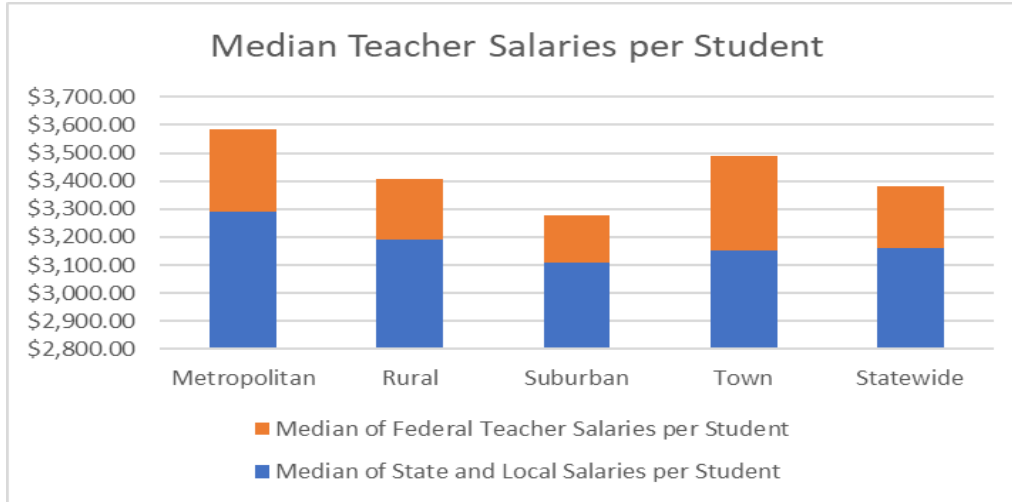
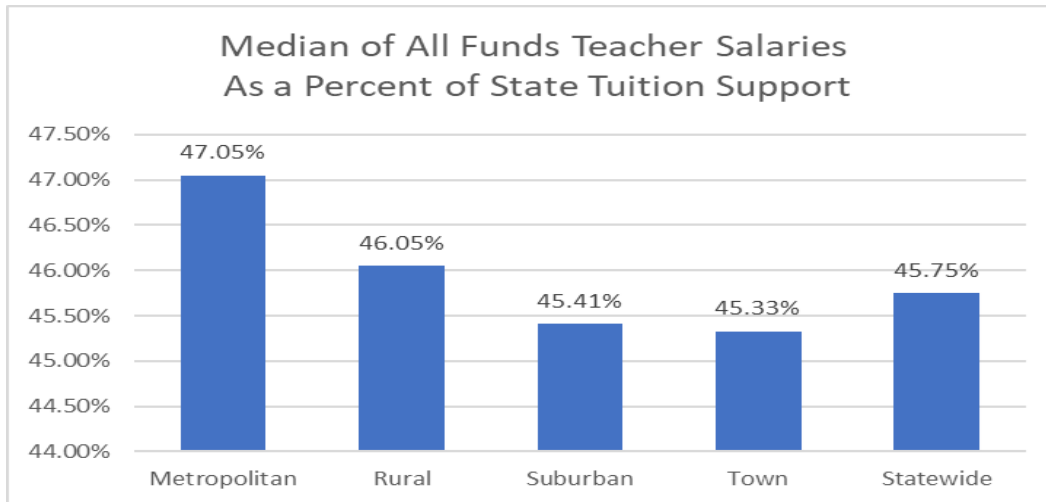


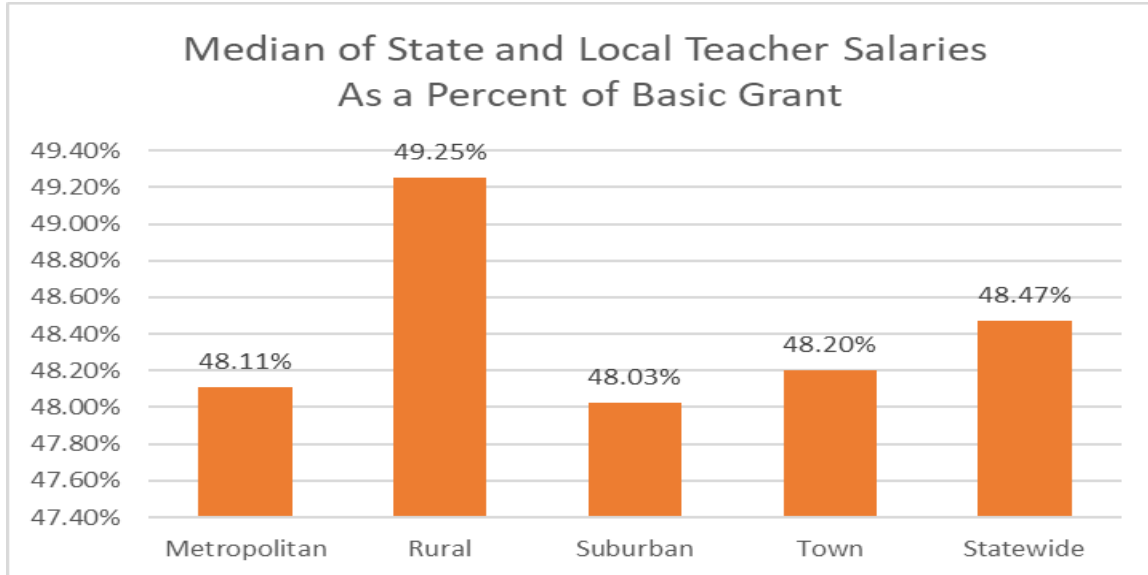
Chart 2D below depicts the Median Teacher Salaries as a Percentage of State Tuition Support for all funds. The statewide median of all funds for full-time teacher salaries as a percentage of state tuition support was 45.75 percent. Classifying school corporations according to metropolitan, rural, suburban, and towns resulted in a range of 45.33 percent to 47.05 percent, with the lower percentage representing school corporations located in towns and the latter percentage representing metropolitan school districts.

Because the Basic Grant, which includes funding for foundation and complexity, provides the largest share of revenue to support full-time teacher salaries, the following chart expresses the median percentage of state and local spending on full-time teacher salaries as compared to the Basic Grant. The percentage ranges from 48.03 percent to 49.25 percent, with rural school corporations slightly exceeding other school types.

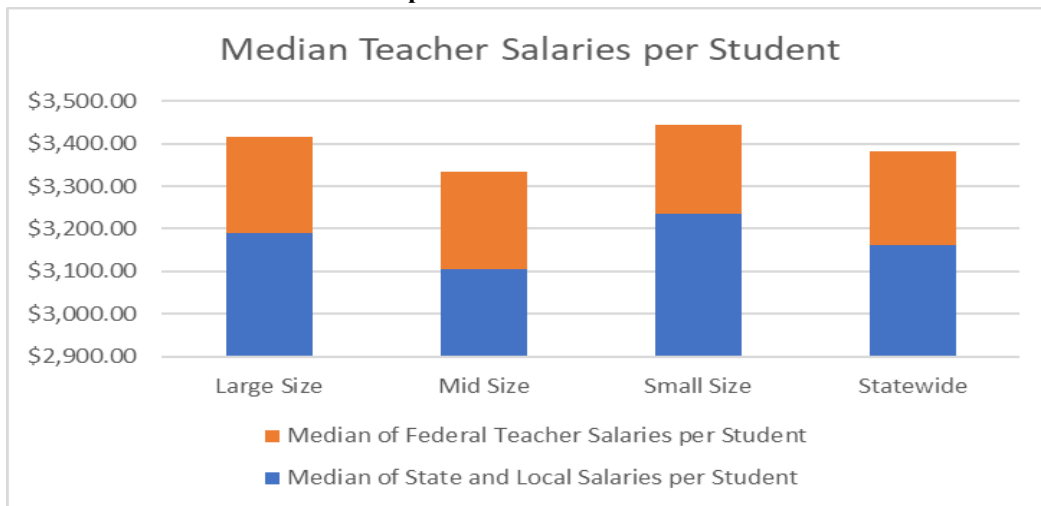
Chart 3D: Median of State and Local Teacher Salaries as a Percentage of the Basic Grant



OVERVIEW- SIZE

In Chart 1S below, small size school corporations had the highest median amount of state and local salaries per student at \$3,234.71, while large size school corporations were slightly behind at \$3,190.20 per student. Including federal funds in the analysis results in a median of \$3,459.00 for small size school corporations and \$3,400.25 for large size school corporations. Overall, the statewide median of salaries for all funds was \$3,388.22.

The statewide median of all funds for full-time teacher salaries as a percentage of state tuition support was 45.75 percent. The range between small size, midsize, and large size

school corporations was 45.38 percent to 46.74 percent with large school corporations on the higher end and mid size school corporations on the lower end but the range falling between one and two percent . (See Chart 2S)

Chart 2S: Median of All Funds Teacher Salaries as a Percent of State Tuition Support

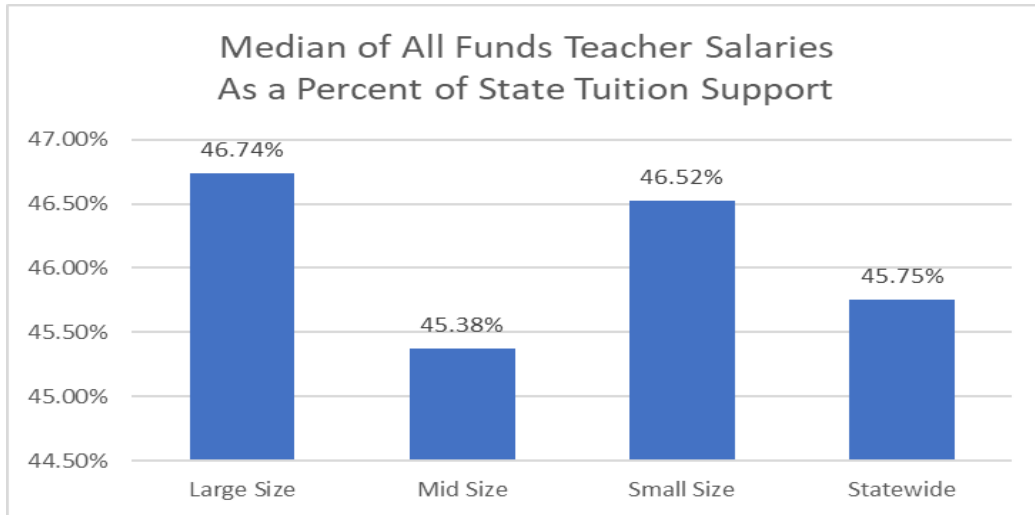
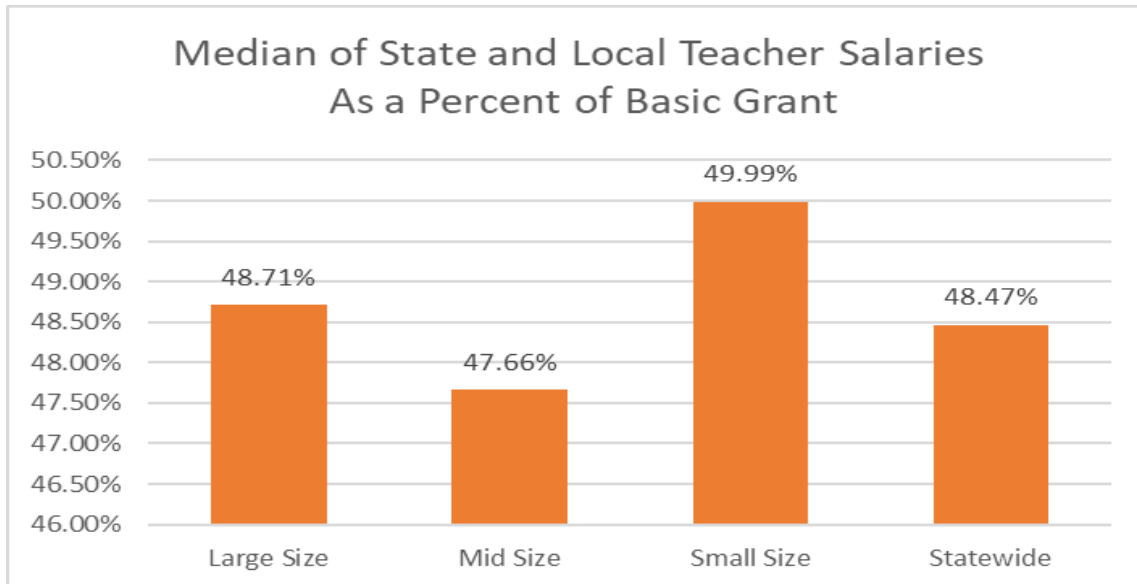


Chart 3S provides the median of state and local teacher salaries as a percent of the Basic Grant. The range was from 47.66 percent for a mid size school district to 49.99 for a small size school district. The statewide median for all school corporations was 48.47 percent.

OVERVIEW- COMPLEXITY

Charts 1C through 4C use complexity as the basis for analyzing the median of state/local salaries per student. Complexity, which is based on the percentage of students that received SNAP, TANF, or foster care assistance in FY 2021, was used in the FY 2022 formula and continues to be used in FY 2023. School corporations with higher complexity had a higher median of total state/local and federal funds per student amount of \$3,614.90. The statewide per student median was \$3,388.22.

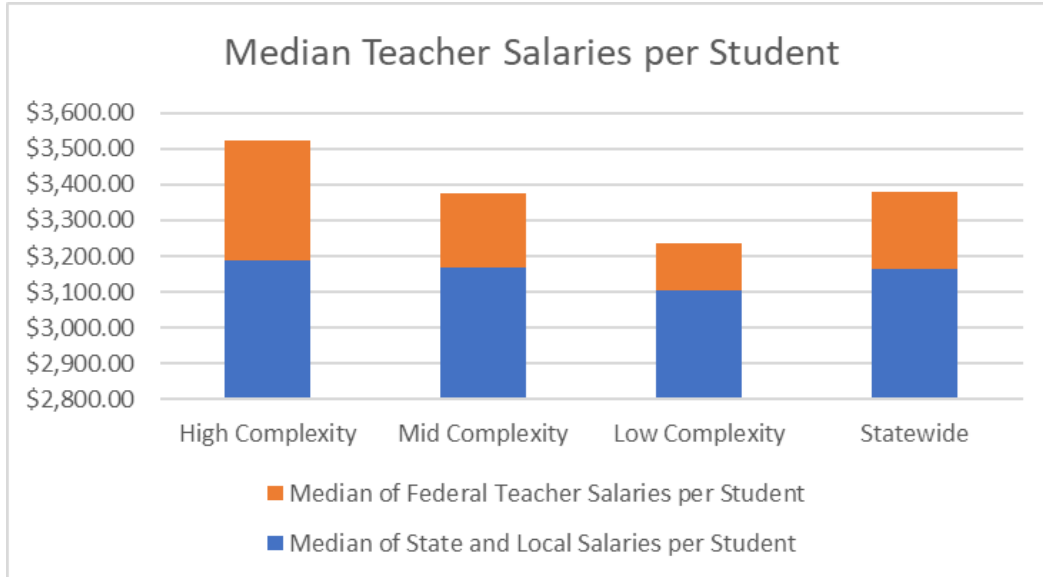
The median of all funds for full-time teacher salaries as a percentage of state tuition support was 45.75 percent, which was the same percentage as that for high complexity schools. (See Chart 1C) Overall, all complexity types exceed the 45% threshold when looking at the overall percent of state tuition support or the overall percent of only the Basic Grant.

When looking at the median teacher salaries per student, the per student amount for all funds ranges between \$3,267.90 for a school corporation with low complexity to \$3,614.90 in a school corporation with a high complexity percentage. The median of salaries (all funds) per student was \$3,388.22, as reflected in Chart 2C.

Charts 3C and 4C reflect a different approach to reviewing the median teachers salary per student amounts by comparing the results to State Tuition Support and the Basic Grant. The median percent of full-time teacher salaries using all funds in the numerator and State Tuition Support, which includes all four grants (Basic, Honors, Career and Technical Education, and Special Education) as the denominator results in closely aligned percentages for all complexity types that hover around the median (45.75 percent). When calculating the median of state and local teacher salaries as a percent of the Basic Grant, school corporations with low complexity spent a higher percent (49.25 percent) on full-time teacher salaries compared to the statewide median of 48.47 percent. Chart 3C: Median of All Funds Teacher Salaries as a Percent of State Tuition Support

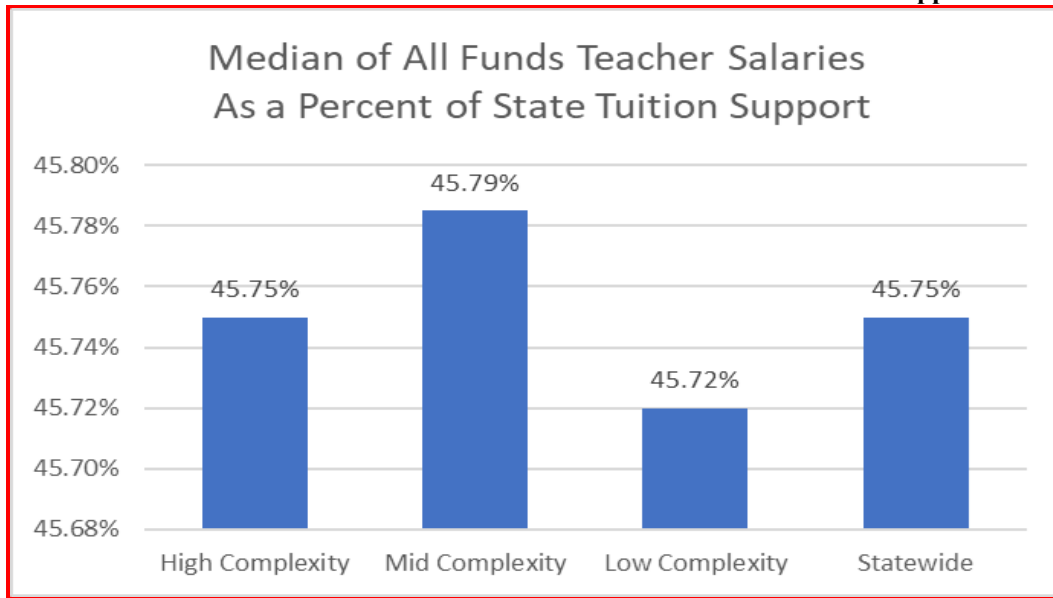
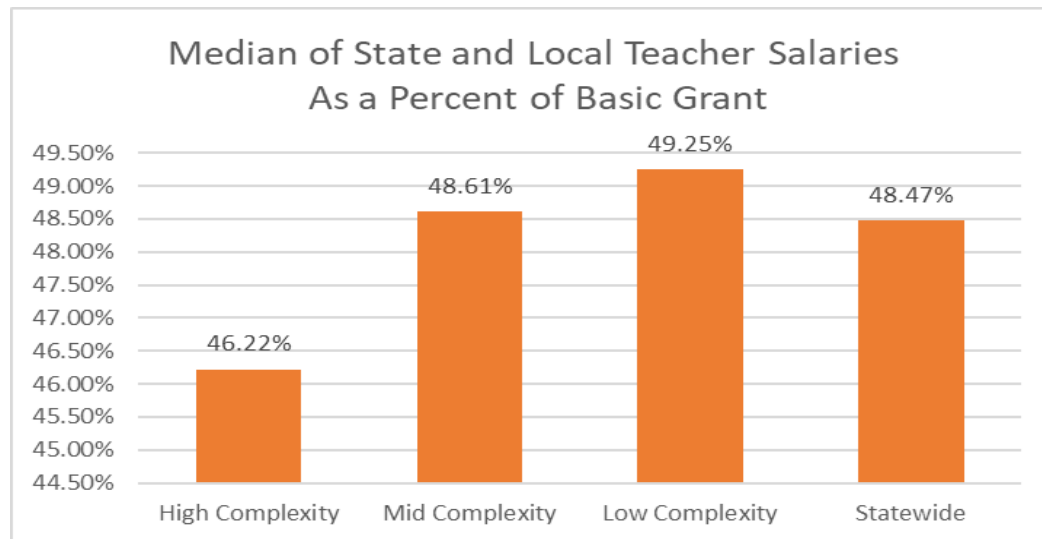


Chart 4C: Median of State and Local Teacher Salaries as a Percent of Basic Grant



WAIVER APPEALS

School corporations that requested a waiver

School corporations that could not comply with the 45% full-time teacher salary expenditure requirement could apply for a waiver from the Department. To assist school corporations with providing information needed to evaluate the waiver request, the Department developed a waiver application. The waiver application included additional documentation that would be helpful to support a school corporation's request for waiver from the 45% expenditure requirement. Additional documentation requested from school corporations included the following:

1. Information concerning the financial challenges currently facing the school corporation.
2. Documentation concerning innovative or efficient approaches in delivering instruction that is responsible for the school corporation being unable to meet the expenditure requirement.
3. Cost saving measures taken by the school corporation in attempting to meet the requirement.
4. Other steps taken by the school corporation in attempting to meet the requirement.
5. Other documentation may include:
 1. Ending cash balances for all funds.
 2. Projected fund balances moving forward.
 3. Other financial information.
 4. Recent trends in average daily membership (ADM).
 5. Outstanding debt.
 6. Deferred capital projects.
 7. Status of any current or future referendums; and/or
 8. Implementation of other measures referenced in the Roadmap for Improving Indiana Teacher Compensation (Next Level Teacher Compensation Commission Report)

Although there was no statutory deadline for submission of a waiver request, DOE imposed a deadline of September 30, 2022, for the appeal. Appendix A provides a list of all school corporations, their percentage, which school corporations did or did not meet the 45 percent expenditure for full-time teacher salaries, those school corporations that filed a waiver, and the waiver outcome (approved or denied). For FY 2022, one hundred thirteen schools were under the 45 percent threshold and all but one of the school corporations filed a waiver request, which represents 39 percent of school corporations.

As part of its review process, the Department could approve a one-year exception to the waiver requirement for school corporations that exhausted reasonable efforts in attempting to meet the 45 percent expenditure requirement. For school corporations that received a waiver, the school corporation must work with the Department to develop a plan to identify additional cost saving measures and any other steps that would allow the school corporation to meet the requirement. It should be noted that the Department may not grant more than three waivers to a school corporation.

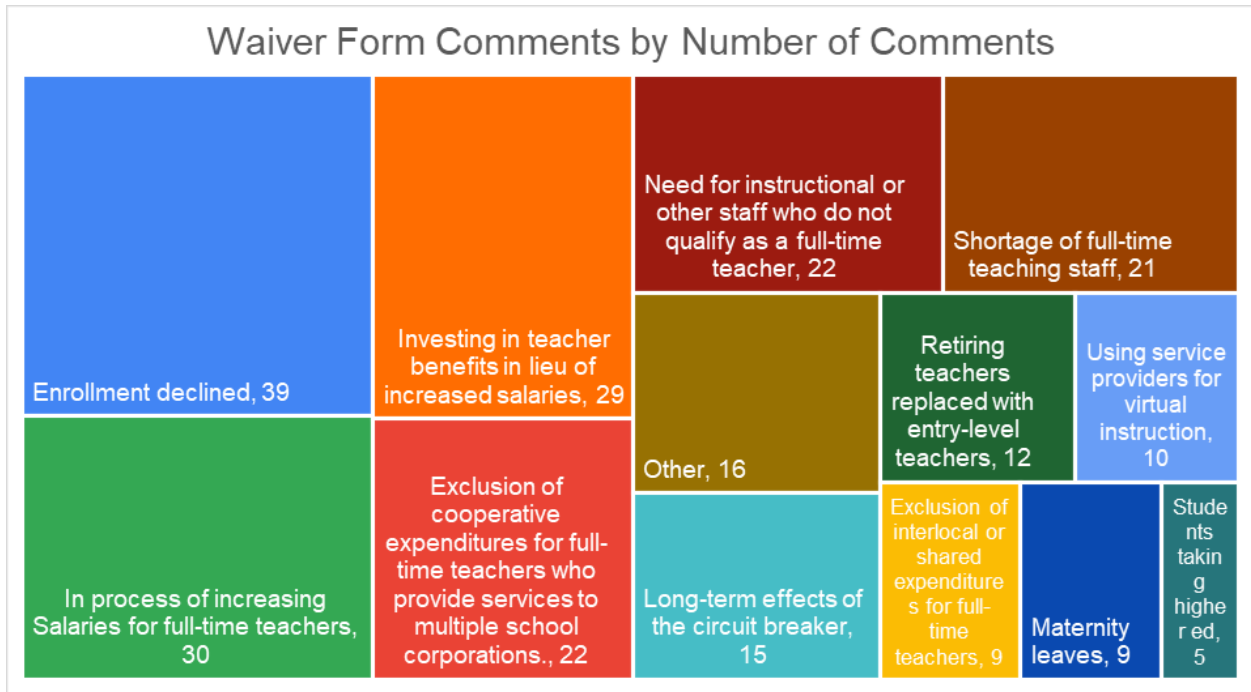
Waiver appeal decision

Based upon its review of the waivers, DOE approved 105 waiver appeals and denied seven school corporations request for a waiver. The denials were largely based on the school corporation's response to the supporting documentation, requested in the waiver

appeal form, which did not adequately indicate how the school corporation attempted to meet the requirement during FY 2022.

Common reasons cited by appealing school corporations for not meeting the forty-five percent expenditure requirement for full-time teacher salaries are reflected in the chart below.

BENEFITS

Percent and amount expended by school corporation and statewide

Because Form 9 financial data did not provide the level of detail needed to determine the amount expended for full-time teacher benefits, school officials self-report expenditures for full-time teacher benefits and classify the data between state/local and federal expenditures. Doing so provides a little more detail on the amount of federal funds being used to provide instructional support at school corporations. The following survey was distributed to school corporations to determine expenditures for full-time teacher benefits.

Teacher Benefit Survey
Submission Period: July 8, 2022 - August 12, 2022

To comply with the requirements of Indiana Code 20-28-9-28 (g), the department must submit a report to the legislative council and state budget committee that contains information as to the percentage and amount that each school corporation expended and the statewide total expended for full-time teacher salaries, the percent and amount each school corporation expended and the statewide total expended for full-time teacher benefits, whether the school corporation met statutory requirements, and whether the school corporation received a waiver.

School corporations must complete this form for the period of July 1, 2021 through June 31, 2022 and include the following information necessary to submit the required report. The department will use FY 2022 Form 9 financial data to compile full-time teacher salary information for a portion of the report.

All two hundred-ninety school corporations completed the full-time teacher benefit survey. The Department did not request that school corporations break-out benefits for a full-time teacher who also received additional compensation. For example, benefits were not separated into different categories for a teacher who was compensated as a full-time teacher during the school year and who also received additional compensation for serving as a teacher in a summer-school program.

Survey responses can be found in Appendix B. Statewide total expenditures from all funds for full-time teacher benefits were \$1,227,566,095 for all reported categories. This represents 17.12 percent of the \$7,168,754,004.53 of state tuition support dollars received by the 290 school corporations. Insurance benefits, at 8.78 percent, slightly outpaced salary/retirement benefits.

Classifying the various categories into three primary sections results in the costs reflected below. The three classifications used were Salary/Retirement Benefits, Insurance Benefits, and Other Benefits. The information above shows that the percentage of funds spent on insurance benefits is slightly larger than salary/retirement benefits. Other benefits, which are other benefit types available at various school corporations, were less than one percent of state tuition support, representing the lowest overall classification.

Information shows the amount expended for full-time teacher benefits was primarily for state/local funds, which included the Education fund. There were local positions paid from Title and other federal funds, which are captured in the federal funds amount (\$38,816,703) reported for full-time teachers. On a statewide basis, social security and contributions toward the teachers retirement fund represent the majority of expenditures for salary/retirement benefits.

As Chart 3B shows, Group Health Insurance represented the largest portion of expenditures for full-time teacher insurance benefits. Health Savings Account or VEBA Contributions were next followed by expenditures for Dental Insurance. The majority of benefit expenditures were from the state and local funds (\$579,346,805.24) with a much smaller amount (\$50,059,701.98) from federal funds.

Other Benefits

Other benefits were reported in both state/local and federal expenditures and reflect the smallest share of total benefits reported. Other benefits are offered at the discretion of school governing with the largest amount in the Other Benefits categories not specified in the survey. These include tuition reimbursement, food service staff meals, and entertainment. (See Chart 4B below)

Additional points regarding the benefits survey include:

- Health and dental benefits were combined for some school corporations that could not delineate the costs.
- Benefits for some full-time teachers may reflect more than one position held by the teacher. (i.e. full-time teacher who also serves as a part-time coach might have adjustments for social security and other benefits associated with each role)

SALARIES AND BENEFITS COMBINED

Percent and amount expended by school corporation and statewide

Statewide expenditures from all funds for full-time teacher salaries and benefits together totaled \$4,643,274,725.77. (See Appendix C) Comparing this amount to the amount of state tuition support, the percentages ranged from 28.42 percent (Clarksville) to 132.06 percent (West Central) with a median value of 62.08 percent of tuition support. Clarksville and West Central were noted as outliers earlier in the report due to an outsourced virtual education program and the school corporation-based cooperative education.

The chart below shows the ranges of salaries and benefits to the amount of tuition support for all funds, with the largest number of school corporations falling between the range of 56 to 65 percent. The second Chart (2S/B) displays the ranges of salaries and benefits restricted to state and local funds compared to the amount of Basic Grant received by the school corporation, with the largest number of school corporations falling between the range of 60 to 69 percent. The percentages are affected by the inclusion and exclusion of cooperative expenditures and other joint service expenditures for full-time teachers.

Chart 1S/B: Percent of Salaries/Benefits for All School Corporations

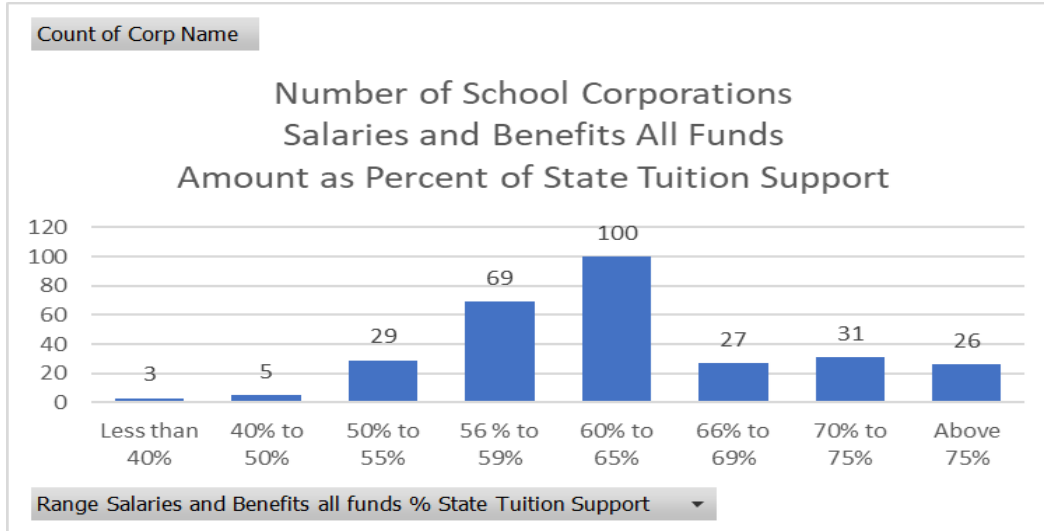
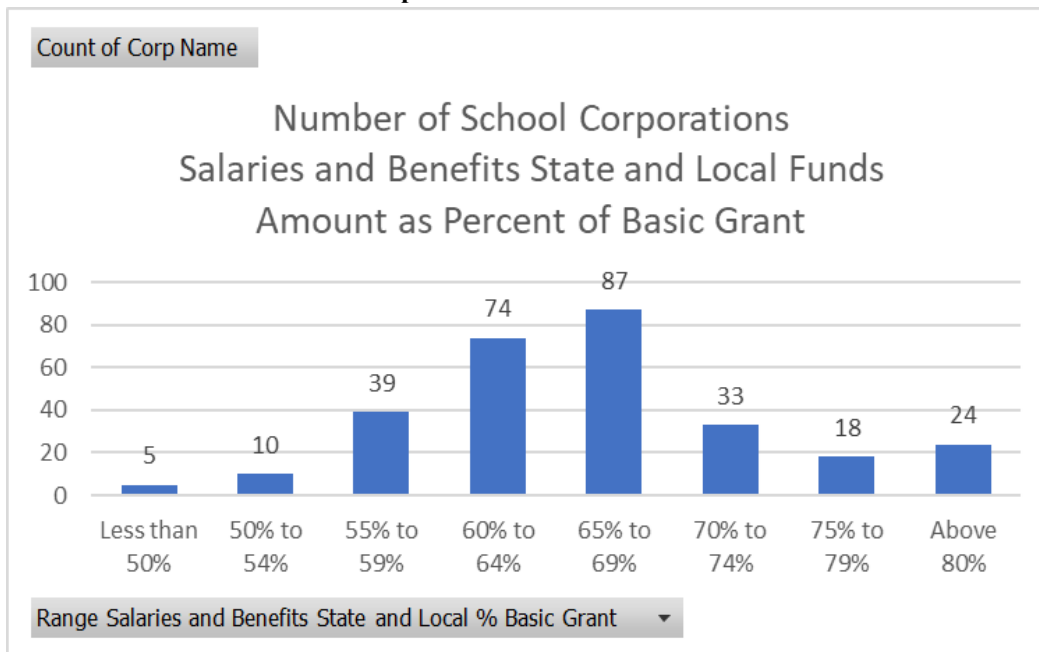


Chart 2 S/B: Percent of School Corporation as Percent of Basic Grant



SUMMARY

It should be noted that the full-time teacher salary expenditure requirement was amended in the last session to include a proportionate share of expenditures for full-time teacher salaries made by a cooperative with the full-time teacher expenditures reported by a school corporation. The language took effect on July 1, 2022, and a proportionate share of expenditures for full-time teachers will be included in next year’s report. The language did not incorporate full-time teacher salaries expended by school corporations

that participate in an interlocal, joint service, education service center, or shared-service agreements.

The recent pandemic shifted some priorities and required some school corporations to expand their focus on remedial education and mental health needs. With that, school corporation programs and services depend on finding the appropriate balance of salaries and benefits offered to full-time teachers, and other school corporation employees, to ensure academic success for its students and personal and professional success for its employees. As the Department works to further delineate school corporation expenditures through the Chart of Accounts, additional data will be available to identify the different types of employees who contribute to the academic success of our students.
