## Ed-Flex Waiver FAQ

- 1. What are the differences between the four waivers on the application?
  - Waiver #1 is a carryover waiver that LEAs can apply for if they would like to increase their maximum carryover percentage from 15% to 25%. Using this would not count as an excess carryover waiver that LEAs can use once every 3 years.
  - Waiver #2 allows LEAs to apply to use their own criteria for paraprofessional requirements.
  - Waiver #3 is only for the IDOC.
  - Waiver #4 allows LEAs to apply to eliminate the Title IV, Part A requirement to use 20% of funds in well-rounded education and social-emotional learning categories.
- 2. How many Ed-Flex Waivers can we apply for? My LEA is eligible for Waiver #1, #2, and #4.
  - All LEAs are eligible to apply for all three waivers. The difference is that Waiver #1 has to be applied for annually, but Waivers #2 and #4 last through June 30, 2024 once approved.
- 3. We already applied for Waiver #2 but now we want to apply for Waiver #1, what do we do?
  - Go ahead and apply, we will add this waiver application to our records. You can apply for Waiver #4 now too if you would like.
- 4. We would like to apply for Waiver #2, but we would like to use paraprofessional requirements that are not in the IDOE's suggestions list, what do we do?
  - On the waiver application, you have to choose what your requirements will be. You can choose from the IDOE suggestions or add your own.



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- 5. We have been approved for Waiver #2 and the waiver lasts through June 30, 2024. What will the paraprofessional requirements be after that date?
  - At this time we anticipate the requirements will go back to the previous requirements of passing the ParaPro test or completing two years of college.
