Manage Your Route To School

School Bus Drivers:

As the driver, you have the premiere safety seat on the bus. It is your job to ensure the safety of your young riders. When planning the route - avoid railroad crossings whenever possible.

When you do cross the tracks, follow this Safety Route Reminder:

Advance Warning
This sign tells you to
slow down - tracks ahead.

2 Check Traffic Behind

Engage bus' parking lights, pull out

of lane, if necessary. (Follow your school district's policies)







Prepare Bus
Quiet students before
stopping, turn off radio
and fan.

Look & Listen
For train in both
directions. Open
door, window to listen.

Doubletake before crossing.

Stop Bus

Stop at least 15 ft from crossing, further back if necessary.
