## Condition Name:

Arboviral Disease or Infection, Domestic

## Condition Name in NBS:

- West Nile Virus, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive
- St. Louis Encephalitis, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive
- Eastern Equine Encephalitis, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive
- Western Equine Encephalitis, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive
- California Serogroup Virus Diseases
- Lacrosse Virus, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive
- Jamestown Canyon Virus, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive
- Powassan Virus, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive

## Reporting Timeframe:

- Immediately Reportable – Eastern Equine Encephalitis, Neuroinvasive/Non-Neuroinvasive
- Within One Working Day – All other Arboviral Diseases listed above

## Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Isolation of virus from, or demonstration of specific viral antigen or nucleic acid in, tissue, blood, CSF, or other body fluid, EIA, virus-specific quantitative antibody titers.
- Virus-specific IgM antibodies in CSF or serum \*If positive, forward to IDOH Labs for further testing.

## Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment Information sections within NBS morbidity report

## Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable medical records including outpatient office visits, specialty consults, and emergency department/hospital discharge summaries, recent travel history.
- Negative results for other arboviral IgM antibodies in CSF or serum
- Name and contact information of follow up provider should be listed in the Administrative Comments section of the morbidity report.
