Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- Direct fluorescent antibody test, results from culture, IFA, identification in CSF or serum, or RT-PCR.

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report.
- Contact the Vector-borne and Zoonotic Disease Program (business hours) or the Epidemiologist On-Call (after hours) immediately to report.
- If you are wanting to report rabies PEP administration, please follow the Reportable Condition Reporting Guidance for Rabies, Postexposure Prophylaxis Administration page.

Additional Documentation to Include

- Medical records (if available)
- Hospital Discharge Summary (if available)
- Specialty consults (if available)
