Condition Name:

**Salmonellosis,
non-typhoidal**

Condition Name in NBS:

Salmonellosis, excluding *S. typhi* and *S. paratyphi*

Reporting Timeframe:

Within One Working Day

TO REPORT:

- NBS users: Report conditions via Morbidity Report in **NBS**
- Non-NBS users: Report with **this** form

Associated Reportable Laboratory Results

- *Salmonella* species from a clinical specimen (all test types and specimen types)
- Antimicrobial susceptibility testing

Condition Specific Reporting Details

- Clinical, Epidemiologic, Lab Report, and Treatment information sections within the NBS Morbidity Report

Additional Documentation to Include

- Applicable lab results
- Applicable patient medical records (if available)
- Any noted exposure history, including travel
