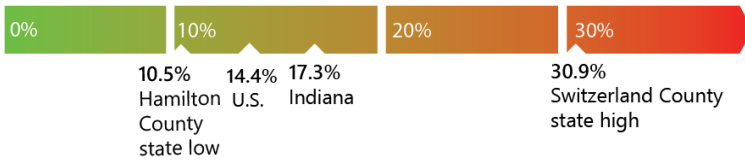

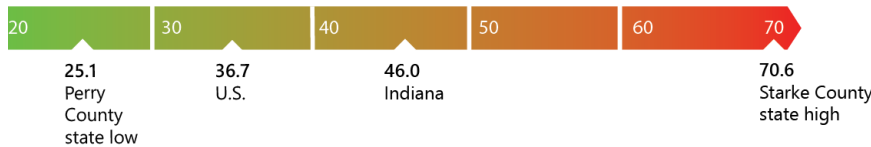

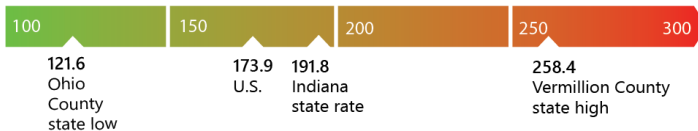
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **22.6%**



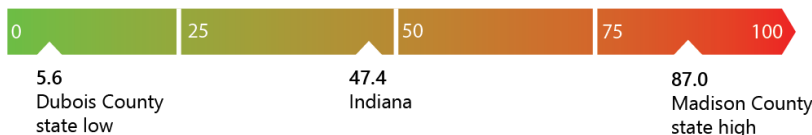
