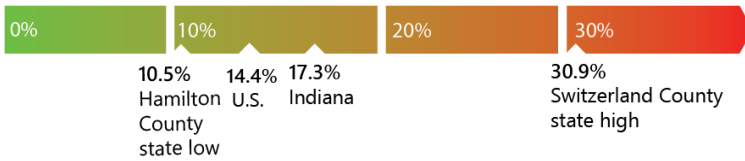

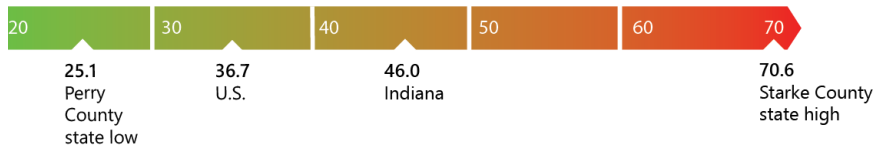

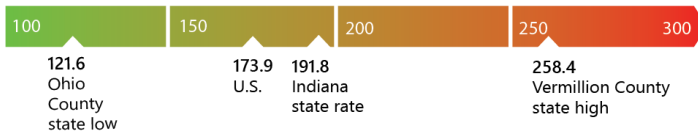
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **28.5%**



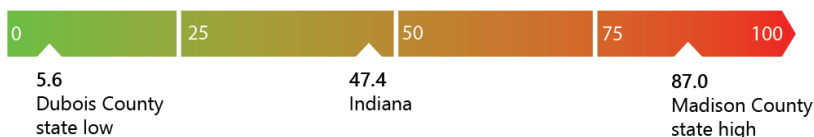
