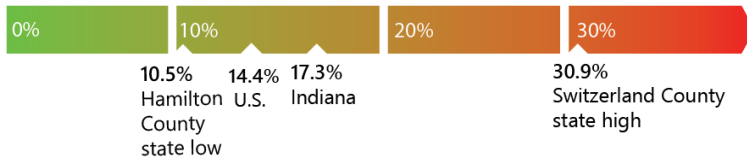

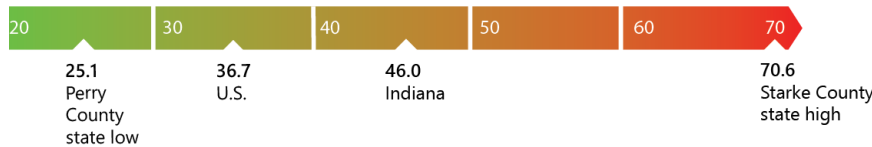
There is no tobacco control grant in Union County for 2023-2025.

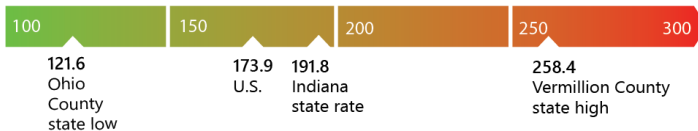
 **Percent of adults who smoke** **29.0%**



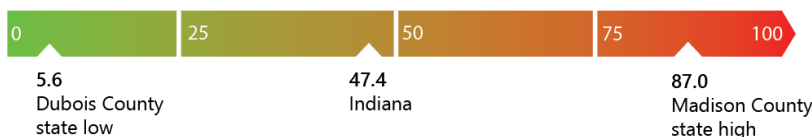
