ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

RACE 3: Superfecta wagering canceled – scratched down to 5 runners.

RACE 4: HISA crop rule violation – Gregory Romero (#2 OUT OF PROMISES) committed at class 3 violation of HISA 2280(b)(1) by striking his mount 9 times. Romero has waived his hearing and will be suspended 1 day (Nov. 7), fined \$250, and assessed three penalty points.

RACE 5: Program correction - #7 TURBO GAL raced with blinkers in her previous start, races with blinkers today.

RACE 5: HISA crop rule violation – Hannah Leahey (#6 RAFAELLE) committed at class 3 violation of HISA 2280(b)(1) by striking her mount 7 times. Leahey has waived her hearing and will be suspended 1 day (Nov. 7), fined \$250, and assessed three penalty points.

RACE 11: Trainer objection – Jessica Vazquez, trainer of 8th place finisher #6 IVORY SIX PACK, lodged a claim of foul against 1st place finisher #5 NAMGIS KODIAK KISS and 6th place finisher #7 KISS OF VALOR alleging interference at the start. Stewards reviewed video replay and noted that IVORY SIX PACK was away a step slowly and then sandwiched by the other two as #5 bore outward and #7 inward. However, IVORY SIX PACK had clear running room the entire rest of the way, failed to gain ground and eventually was passed by others in deep stretch. It was determined that even though the horse was interfered with, the interference did not cost her a better finishing position. The claim of foul was disallowed.


RACE 12: Program correction - #2 CV STRUTTINFORAKISS is a gelding.

RACE 12: Trainer objection – Ron Raper, trainer of 5th place finisher #6 HAD TO BE IVORY lodged a claim of foul against 4th place finisher, #9 WRS VALENTINO alleging interference in mid-stretch. Stewards reviewed video replay and determined that the contact between the two was both minimal and incidental. Objection was disallowed.

RACE 13: Three-strike violation – Trey Byrd, #7 FUELED BY IVORY. First offense of the meet; \$250 fine.
