ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 7 – Inquiry posted on unofficial second place finisher No. 1 OMYHEART (Darrell Wright) for possible violation of the breaking rule in late stretch. Second inquiry posted on unofficial third place finisher No. 4 T WOODLEY (Marvin Luna) for possible violation of the breaking rule before the 1/4. Video showed that driver Luna complied with all aspects of the breaking rule and there was no reason to disqualify No. 4 T WOODLEY. Reviewing video in the stretch No. 1 OMYHEART was off stride through the finish and lapped on by two horses. The horse also drifted out into the path of unofficial fourth place finisher No. 6 IMALOVELYLADY (Mike Oosting) and interfered with that horse while on a break. Either way, No. 1 OMYHEART finished second placed fourth for violation of the breaking rule.

Race 12 – Inquiry posted on unofficial second place finisher No. 4 JKS LUCKY LOU for possible pylon and breaking rule violations at the top of the stretch. Video showed that Bender struck a pylon but was not inside of any. The judges also determined that Mr. Bender complied with all aspects of the breaking rule. No reason for disqualification and the horse was placed as finished.
