ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 1 – Inquiry posted on unofficial race winner #2 WHISKEY WIZZARD (John DeLong) for possible violation of the pylon rule in the far turn going to 3/4. Video showed that Mr. DeLong was inside of one pylon and struck two more. The horse did not gain an unfair advantage and therefore there was no reason for disqualification. Horse placed as originally finished.

Race 5 – No. 1 MONTY'S MISSION originally finished ninth placed tenth for violation of the breaking rule (extended break) in the stretch.


Race 11 – The test barn called and reported that owner Julie Kain came to the test barn with the horse SCORECARD DAN and caused a great deal of commotion including going after the test barn attendant who was made to feel very uncomfortable by her husband, Greg Kain, earlier in the spring. Gregory and Julie Kain both summarily suspended by the judges.


Race 12- Two separate inquiries posted. The first was regarding No. 10 KID TYLER (LeWayne Miller) and whether the horse made the fair start pole. Video showed that the horse was not inside the fair start pole prior to the rest of the field being released. No. 10 KID TYLER declared a non-starter for wagering purposes. Refunds issued on No. 10 KID TYLER.


Second inquiry posted on no. 3 ALL STAR SWAN (Brad Ferguson) for possible violation of the breaking rule in the first turn going to the quarter. Driver Ferguson complied with all aspects of the breaking rule and the horse was placed as finished.
