ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 5 – Inquiry posted on unofficial fourth place finisher No. 4 WINDEX WILLIE (Trace Tetrick) for possible violation of the breaking rule and pylon rule after ¾ and entering the stretch. No. 4 WINDEX WILLIE made a break before ¾ with driver Tetrick taking the horse inside the pylons because clearance did not exist to take the horse to the outside. Tetrick was deemed to have complied with the breaking rule. The second part of the inquiry concerned the horse racing inside of the pylons in the stretch. While the horse was inside pylons driver Tetrick waited for all contending horses to pass him before reentering the track. The judges determined that because no interference occurred, no unfair advantage was gained that there ultimately was no reason to place the horse. All horses placed as originally finished.

Race 6 – No. 7 CREEDMORE (Atlee Bender) originally finished eighth placed tenth for an extended break in the stretch. Chad Clark, driver of No. 8 DOVER IN ACTION, warned about using too much elbow while whipping in the stretch.
