ADMINISTRATIVE ACTIONS, NOTES, COMMENTS

Race 2 – Inquiry posted on unofficial third place finisher No. 3 SWEET TRUTH (LeWayne Miller) for possible pylon violation in the far turn before $\frac{3}{4}$. Video showed that the horse was inside one pylon and struck two others without gaining an unfair advantage. No. 3 SWEET TRUTH placed as finished.

Race 9 – Superfecta wagering on the race cancelled per IHRC wagering rules with the scratch of No. 9 DOWNBYTHEOCEAN reducing the field to five betting interests.

Race 11 – Inquiries posted on unofficial second place finisher No. 6 BILLY CLYDE (John DeLong) and unofficial fourth place finisher No. 5 JK VICTORY (Trace Tetrick) for possible pylon violations in the far turn before $\frac{3}{4}$. Video showed that No. 6 BILLY CLYDE was inside of three consecutive pylons. Per IHRC rules a horse inside three consecutive pylons may be placed last. No. 6 BILLYCLYDE finished second placed sixth for pylon violation. Video shows that No. 5 JK VICTORY was inside two consecutive pylons and lapped on at the finish. Per IHRC rules a horse inside two consecutive pylons shall be placed behind horses that it is lapped on by. The horse originally finished fourth was placed third with the first disqualification then placed behind the horses it was lapped on by. No. 5 JK VICTORY disqualified placed fifth. Both Tetrick and DeLong fined \$200.00
