Thank you for your September 29, 2011 request to remove the "Added Costs to Industry and Agriculture" Beneficial Use Impairment (BUI) in the Grand Calumet River Area of Concern (AOC), Lake County, Indiana. We very much share your desire to restore the health of all of the Great Lakes AOCs and to formally delist them.

Based upon a review of your submittal and the supporting data, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency hereby approves your BUI removal request. Further, we will notify the International Joint Commission of this significant positive change in the environmental health of the Grand Calumet River AOC.
