3-Tiered Membership

Bronze Level

- Have a positive environmental history as determined by an IDEM compliance check
- Join the Program by adopting a sustainability resolution or ordinance (to show high level community commitment)
- Create a Clean Team (to show dedicated resources are available to achieve sustainability goals)
 - Attend the Clean Annual Meeting





3-Tiered Membership

Silver Level

- Meet Bronze level requirements
- Post information on the community's web site about what has been accomplished.
- Be recognized for implementing between 4 8
 best practices (depending on community size)
- Measure and report on performance metrics





3-Tiered Membership

Gold Level

- Meet Bronze and Silver level requirements
- Implement at their own pace an additional 4 8
 best practices (depending on community size)
 - Measure and report on performance metrics





Project Requirements

- Number of projects is based on population (Small Community=4, Medium Community=6, Large Community=8)
- Examples of approved project categories include but are not limited to:
 - 1. Waste Management/Reduction
 - 2. Energy/Renewables
 - 3. Land Use/Conservation
 - 4. Community Resiliency

- Become a Sol Smart Community
- Track & Report Municipal Water Use
- Create Community Gardens
- Become a Tree City USA
- Conduct a Greenhouse Gas Inventory
- Conduct a Brownfields Inventory
