Dilgard Stock Rotation

When Dilgard receives a commodity load:

- The Product is verified as ours and correctly corresponds with the BOL.
- Each pallet is counted and tagged as it comes off the trailer.
 - Item number,
 - Date received,
 - Date it was manufactured or best buy date,
 - The amount of cases on each pallet.
 - Use color coordinated paper to tell apart closely related items.
- This tells the employees staging the product
 - Where it goes in rotation.
 - Which in turn tells the employee pulling orders which pallet to pull from next.

FIFO is used everyday throughout Dilgard's warehouse for commodity items as well as our non-commodity items.

Dilgard has perishable and dated products arriving daily in all aspects of our business. Proper stock rotation is standard operating procedure at all times.
