


4 Ethics Commission Activity

Formal Advisory Opinions




261 informal advisory opinions

2013 Annual Report, Office of the Indiana Inspector General

In 2013, the investigations of Inspector General Special Agents resulted in five criminal arrests and the filing of three ethics complaints (details of these cases are on our website: www.in.gov/ig):

> 2011-04-0153 INDOT FUEL THEFT Theft of \$26,000 gasoline charged by Jennings County Prosecutor

2013-05-0095 STATE CONTRACTOR THEFT (4 arrests) Theft of \$36,000 in child support money charged by Marion County Prosecutor

> 2012-07-0177 IDEM POST-EMPLOYMENT State employee went to work for companies he regulated

2013-08-0149 DOE USE OF STATE PROPRTY State Superintendent of Education used state property for political activity


> 2012-12-0305 FSSA USE OF STATE PROPERTY FSSA employee used state property to run outside business
