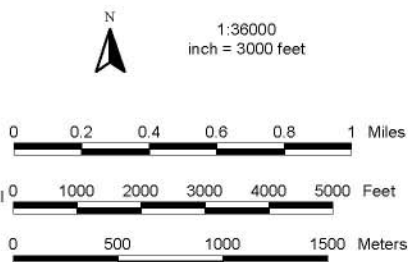


I-69 EVANSVILLE TO INDIANAPOLIS STUDY

COVERAGE: CR 450 S (S of Veale Creek) to Eagan Ditch (E of CR 250 E).
 CITIES/TOWNS: Washington, South Washington (Daviess County)
 STREAM CROSSINGS: Veale Creek (mainstem and tributary), Hurricane Branch of Veale Creek (mainstem and tributary), Eagan Ditch
 INTEREST: Farmland, scattered homes and few businesses (US 150/50), Veale Creek wetlands, lake near Hurricane Branch, natural gas pipelines, high voltage powerline (345,000), RR crossing, Daviess County Airport (north), water tower/tank (south), churches and cemeteries, orchard (S of Veale Crk), possible classified forest, some hilly terrain.
 POTENTIAL INTERCHANGES: US 50/US 150
 POTENTIAL GRADE SEPARATION: CR 450 S, CR 50 W, CR 300 S, SR 257, RR Crossing, CR 100 N, CR 200 N, CR 350 E
 OTHER: Plainville Sand Dune Region (NW corner), US 150 is a proposed State Scenic Byway. In the north, the corridor is widened beyond 2000 feet to provide additional flexibility for impact avoidance/minimization in Tier 2.
 PHYSIOGRAPHIC REGION: Wabash Lowland
