MORRISTOWN, Ind. - Tomorrow, our parents will go to the school to vote for president. The kids in Mrs. Prigg's first grade class will vote too.


President Bill Clinton wants to serve four more years in the White House. He is a Democrat. Bob Dole is a Republican who says he can do the job better.

Elizabeth, but people call her "Liddy." She likes to walk into crowds and chat with people. She used to work with the American Red Cross.


He has a daughter who is grown up. Bob Dole used to be a senator. He has a dog, too.
